

Mechanics for Poster Awards Consideration

1. Scoring sheet will be used as a tool.
2. In principle, each discipline will have at least 2 judges, and each judge will take care of at least 2 disciplines (please see the table below).
3. The judges will read the abstract book for screening the merit of all posters in advance.
4. Each judge will be responsible to consider and do scoring for the posters in his/her designated discipline(s), but this is not limited to. Preferably, the judges will consider and give score to any posters he/she considered outstanding although apart from his/her designated fields*.
5. *Each judge will send scoring sheet with the top 5 highest rank to the committee.* (Time is needed to prepare the certificate for the winners)
6. Finally, all scores from all judges will be collected and ranked accordingly, regardless of disciplines. The top 10 will be the winners of poster awards.

*The reason to put each judge on the specific discipline(s) is only to have at least 2 judges who are keen in the specific area have responsibility to consider and scoring the posters in those areas. The

judges are encouraging to consider and give score to any posters he/she consider outstanding although apart from his/her designated fields. By this way, the scoring will be more harmonized since the scores come from many judges, not only 2 in the designated disciplines.
