ABSTRACT ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATION

Abstract template

The abstract template must be used. The template is available for download from the [ifbbs website](#) and inside the abstract submission system.

It is possible to copy/paste your abstract text into the template.

Design of abstract

Abstract should be submitted with the following information:

- Abstract Title.
- Abstract text should have the following outline: Introduction, material and methods, results and conclusion.
- Abstract must be informative and represent the oral or poster's content.
- Tables, figures and references shall not be included in the abstract.
- Choose suggested track and category for your abstract.
- Corresponding author's name, address and e-mail.
- Authors: First name, last name, title, hospital / institution, department, city, country.
- Presenting author should be first.
- Length of abstract text: Maximum 2000 characters (without spaces).

Approval of abstracts

Abstracts will be judged and evaluated for oral/poster presentation. Acceptance or rejection will be sent to authors before early deadline for registration for the congress.

Some abstracts assigned for posters, will be selected for a short oral poster presentation as part of a scientific session.

The scientific committee reserves the right to place an abstract in the track and category they find suitable.
